BYLAW NO. 13--1992

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 7--1989.

The Council for the Town of Indian Head in the Province of Saskatchewan in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 7--1989 is amended as hereinafter set forth.
2. The words in Section 5 are hereby repealed and the following words substituted therefor:
 "No person who owns, keeps, houses, harbours or allows a dog to stay in his premises shall allow such dog to bark or howl excessively."
3. The words in Section 12 are hereby repealed and the following words substituted therefor:

"Any person who contravenes any provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and is liable on summary conviction to minimum fine of \$200.00 and a maximum fine not in excess of \$500.00 or, in default of payment of the fine and costs, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 30 days."
