People who are out walking or enjoying their own yards can feel threatened even by a friendly dog, and with the nice weather more people are spending time outdoors. Do your part to help reduce the possibilities of dangerous situations, and be respectful of your neighbors, by always keeping your dog inside a secure enclosure while at home and on a leash while out walking.

## 2021 SAMA Revaluation Year

The provincial government mandates the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) to conduct periodic revaluations of all Saskatchewan properties every four years to coincide with the change to a new base date. The next revaluation is to be done in 2021 using a 2019 base date. What this means is that your property will be assessed based on the value of properties on January 1, 2019.

When a revaluation is completed, SAMA provides new values to each municipality. Provincial legislation requires municipalities to use these values when determining taxes.
