Water Rate Changes for 2022

The water and sewer rates for the Town of Indian Head have increased for 2022 starting January 1st. For 2022 the minimum quarterly billing for the first 9,000 Imperial gallons of water consumed is \$117.30. Each additional 1,000 gallons from 9,001 to 18,000 gallons is charged at \$4.37 per 1,000 gallons, or part thereof. Consumption above 18,000 gallons is charged at \$5.29 per 1,000 gallons, or part thereof. The quarterly sewer rate for 2022 is set at \$66.24. These services are billed quarterly (January 1- March 31, April 1- June 30, July 1- September 30, and October 1- December 31). Contact the Town Office for current information about water and sewer connections.

Payments for utility billings can be made by cash, cheque, debit card, online, or at your bank. When paying online please use the account number located on the bill.
