

## Town of Indian Head

### Bylaw No. 4--2002

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 3--2002, KNOWN AS THE TRAFFIC BYLAW.

The Council of the Town of Indian Head, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 3--2002 as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 3--2002 is amended by inserting the year "1999" to replace the year "1989" in section 3 (j) subsection (2).
2. Bylaw No. 3--2002 is amended by inserting the following subsection immediately after section 3(j) subsection (4):

(5) *Subsections (1) and (2) shall not apply* to operators of school buses, maintenance vehicles for the Town of Indian Head, or emergency vehicles as defined in The Vehicle Equipment Regulations 1987 for Saskatchewan.

1. Bylaw No. 3--2002 is amended by inserting the following two subsections immediately following section 3) in Appendix "11" to Bylaw No. 3--2002:
  - 4) Thirty (30) kilometres per hour within Sunshine Mobile Park.
  - 5) Thirty (30) kilometres per hour within any mobile home park delineated by posted signs.
2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when adopted by council.




