How do I know there is an emergency?

The primary method Indian Head Emergency Measures (EMO) will use to alert the public of an alarm will be a siren. **An emergency alert will be indicated by a very long continuous blast on the siren – or by Police/ EMO personnel with loud hailers.**

!!!! DO NOT CALL 911 !!!!

What do I do upon hearing the Emergency alert signal?

Upon hearing this siren please turn on your **radio** to **620** on the A.M. band (**CKRM**). Indian Head EMO will be providing this station, the Town Website and the Town Facebook Page with information about the nature of the emergency and what you need to do as a result of it. **Please remain in your home, monitor the radio station and follow instructions as they are issued via the radio, by police or fire or EMO personnel.**

If we decide to leave our home during an emergency situation what should we do?

If you leave your home because of an **evacuation order** or if you decide to leave before the order is given please **fill in the back of this card** with the information requested and hang it in your window or on your front door where it can be plainly seen. **This will assist EMO personnel to locate you and ensure your safety.**
